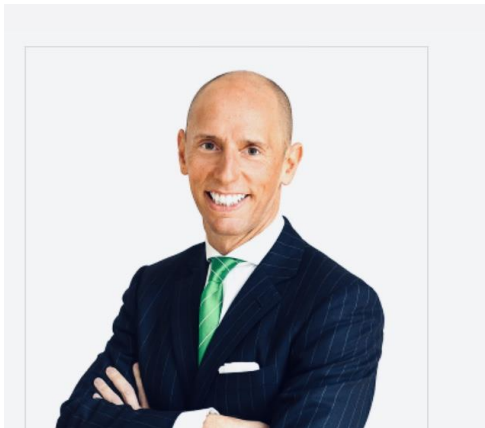


MARC MUKASEY
